Following this, the Local Court of Bremen ordered provisional insolvency proceedings and appointed Dr Christian Kaufmann from PLUTA Rechtsanwalts GmbH as the provisional administrator on 21 January 2019.

After successfully developing biodegradable coffee capsules, the company has recently been working on the development of a paper capsule. The development work has already reached an advanced stage. However, due to the high development costs, the company most recently did not have the necessary funds.
